

AFM Announcer to Call the Shots at MotoGP

Laguna Seca promotions recently announced that longtime AFM roadracing announcer John Fosgate would be joining the team of Brian Drebber and Chris Ernst, as one of the event announcers for the Red Bull U.S. Grand Prix.

"This has always been a dream of mine, to help call the event for the world's greatest racers at the largest motorcycle event on the continent," said Fosgate. "Brian Drebber is a veteran of motorsports announcing and a staple of the industry, while Chris Ernst is a phenomenal crowd favorite. In addition to his duties as the announcer at AFM events, Fosgate also races a pair of Yamaha GP bikes - a TZ250 and a TZ125.
